Forum preamble

Throughout history, Algeria has witnessed a flourishing intellectual movement in various sciences, and some of the knowledge treasures written by its scholars and thinkers remain confined to manuscripts to this day, in the hope that those interested will dust them off and reveal them to researchers and scholars. Among the most prominent sciences that attracted the attention of the ancient Algerians and occupied their minds was the study of Arabic and its sciences, including grammar, morphology, rhetoric, prosody, calligraphy, and everything related to the language, both prose and poetry. This proves the authenticity and uniqueness of Algerian literature in terms of taste, refinement, and enjoyment, even if it remains obscure when compared to Arabic literature in general.

In modern times, Algeria has seen the emergence of new linguistic, literary and critical trends. Linguists have devoted themselves to writing research papers on linguistics, phonetics, lexicography, grammar, semantics and other topics, and researchers who have influenced modern linguistic studies have emerged, either by renewing or by establishing the Arab heritage, such as Abderrahmane Hadj-Salah, Abdel Jalil Mortad, and Saleh Belaid, among others. Not far from language, Algerian literature has a strong presence, drawing its boundaries within and outside the country, embodying literature in its finest forms and creations.

Wherever there is literature, there is criticism, and Algerian critics have made considerable efforts in theory and practice, despite the fact that Algerian criticism, like other Arab practices, is based on Western references, theories and methodologies. There have been attempts to develop a distinctive Algerian critical approach, based on and consistent with Algerian literary genres, and to take steps towards establishing a theoretical critical framework and applying it to literary texts produced by Algerian writers.

➤ The forum's problem:

Based on the above, the forum's theme focuses on evaluating the achievements of Algerians in the fields of linguistic, literary and critical studies, and appreciating the enormous intellectual output through which they have contributed to serving the Arabic language and advancing linguistic and literary studies.

What contributions have Algerian linguists made in the past and present? Have their achievements enriched the Arabic library? Can we speak of Algerian literature that rivals world literature in terms of creativity and diversity? Is there an authentic Algerian criticism with its own unique and distinctive characteristics as opposed to Arab and Western criticism, or is it largely derived from Western approaches? What are the characteristics of the Algerian literary and critical experience?

➤ **Forum objectives:**

Through this forum, we aim to achieve a number of objectives, most notably:

- ❖ Introducing Algerian scholars who have made significant contributions, highlighting their linguistic and literary contributions, and their role in enriching the Arab intellectual heritage, both past and present.
- ❖ The need to focus on Algerian linguistic and literary production and highlight its unique characteristics.
- ❖ The need to deepen and consolidate research on the achievements of Algerians in linguistic, literary and critical studies.

➤ **Forum themes:**

- ❖ Theme 1: Achievements of ancient Algerian linguists (grammar, morphology, rhetoric, prosody, etc.)
- ❖ Theme 2: Achievements of modern Algerian linguists (grammar, Arabic linguistics, phonetics, and lexicography).
- ❖ Theme 3: Achievements of ancient Algerian writers in poetry and prose.
- ❖ Theme 4: Achievements of modern Algerian writers.

❖ Theme 5: Modern Algerian criticism between authenticity and dependency, in terms of theory and practice.

- ❖ The research should be written in 16-point font (SakkalMajalla) in the main text and 12-point font in the margins, with a page size of 2 cm on all sides.
- ❖ Submissions are accepted in Arabic, English, and French.

- ❖ Response to accepted submissions: 5 January 2026.
