Ten recommendations to the attention to students

- 1- students must arrive sufficiently in advance : students must be present at 8:00 am on Sunday and Wednesday, and at 11:30 am on Monday and Thursday ;
- 2- students must bring their student cards (which must be valid) ;
- 3- late students may not be allowed to sit the examination after 15 minutes after it has begun (if a student arrives after the examination has begun but before the aforementioned 15 minutes have elapsed, he will not be granted additional time: he must hand in his paper at the same time as their classmates) ;
- 4- no student may leave the examination room before the end of the examination ;
- 5- each student must bring his own complete kit. he must not ask their classmates for a pen, eraser, ruler, calculator or any other item of this nature during the examination ;
- 6- each student must write his full name on the back of their exam paper and sign it ;
- 7- students are strictly prohibited from keeping any documents relating to the lessons taught, under penalty of being suspected of attempted fraud (schoolbags, bags, briefcases, etc. must be left at the entrance to the examination rooms, for example) ;
- 8- mobile phones must be switched off or set to « airplane mode » and kept away from their owners. any student who fails to comply with this recommendation will be suspected of attempted fraud ;
- 9- before leaving the examination room, all students must ensure that they have handed in their exam papers to the invigilators ;
- 10- as a reminder, any attempted fraud (gestural, verbal, or written), or fraud itself, will result in a firm response that will lead the offender to being summoned before the Disciplinary Board of the institution to which that student belongs.
